## SECTION 1. RECLAMATION FEE REAUTHORIZATION

Title IV of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 (30 U.S.C. 1231, et seq.) is amended –

- (a) in section 402 (a) by adding:
- (3) FISCAL YEARS 2022-2036.—All operators of coal mining operations subject to the provisions of this Act shall pay to the Secretary of the Interior, for deposit in the fund, a reclamation fee of 35 cents per ton of coal produced by surface coal mining and produced by underground mining, except that the reclamation fee for lignite coal shall be at a rate of 2 per centum of the value of the coal at the mine, or 10 cents per ton, whichever is less.
- (b) in section 402(b) by striking "2021" and inserting "2036"

## **SECTION 2. MINIMUM PROGRAM STATES**

Title IV of the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 (30 U.S.C. 1231, et seq.) is amended -

(a) in section 402 (g)(8)(A) by striking "\$3,000,000" and inserting "\$5,000,000"

## SECTION 3. BALANCED BUDGET AND EMERGENCY DEFICIT CONTROL ACT EXEMPTION.

Section 255(g)(1)(A) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act (2 U.S.C. 905(g)(1)(A)) is amended by inserting "Payments to states and Indian tribes from the Abandoned Mine Reclamation Fund, mandatory grants to states and tribes (14-5015-0-2-999), retroactive to fiscal year 2013." before "Payments to the United States Territories, Fiscal Assistance (14–0418–0–1–806).".
