Amending the act of May 31, 1945 (P.L.1198, No.418), entitled "An act providing for the conservation and improvement of 2 land affected in connection with surface mining; regulating 3 such mining; providing for the establishment of an Emergency 4 Bond Fund for anthracite deep mine operators; and providing 5 penalties," further providing for land reclamation financial 6 quarantees; and making an inconsistent repeal. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 19.2(b) of the act of May 31, 1945 11 (P.L.1198, No.418), known as the Surface Mining Conservation and 12 Reclamation Act, is amended by adding a clause to read: 1.3 Section 19.2. Land Reclamation Financial Guarantees. -- * * 14 (b) 15 (8) (i) Notwithstanding section 8(a) of the act of June 22, 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), known as "The Clean Streams Law," the 16 following shall be transferred by the department into the 17 18 Reclamation Fee O&M Trust Account: 19 (A) Civil penalties collected for a violation under section 605 of "The Clean Streams Law," which is in any manner connected 20 with or related to a coal mining activity as defined in 25 Pa. 21
